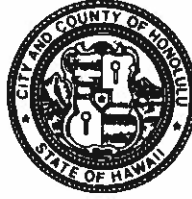

Subject: Status of Shoreline Setback Variance Application No. 2011/SV-9  
Temporary Bypass Road for Replacement Makaha Bridges No. 3 and No. 3A

With Council approval of Resolution No. 11-282 on April 3, 2012, the Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP) will continue processing Shoreline Setback Variance (SV) Application No. 2011/SV-9 for the portions of the temporary bypass road within the shoreline setback area, which are part of the Makaha Bridges replacement project. The DPP held a public hearing on the SV application on March 20, 2012, and has 45 days following the close of the public hearing (ending on May 4, 2012) to grant or deny the SV. We anticipate final action on the application on or close to that date.

The public had the opportunity to comment on the SV application at the public hearing. The agent and State Department of Transportation staff responded to the concerns of those present.
